In 2016 Sandro began a school in Port au Prince with approximately 100 students in grades 1-6. Each subsequent school year we added a new grade, as well as three Pre K and Kindergarten classes, until in 2023 we added our final 13th grade. In 2024, we had our first graduating class and we are praising God for that!

Thank you for joining us on this journey. We are so thankful for all God has done and will continue to do!

We began the 24/25 school year the first week of October and currently have 560 students enrolled. Because of the political unrest in the country some neighboring schools have closed causing an influx of students at our school. We are thankful for every child God brings to our school. Sandro is working hard to make sure things are running as smoothly as possible and that both the staff as well as the students are taken care of. We continue to provide a hot meal every day and thanks to some specific donors were able to once again purchase backpacks for students.

Right now the situation in Port au Prince is especially difficult and dangerous. Most of our students are doing their schoolwork at home and teachers are communicating with them on WhatsApp. Many boys and young men are turning to gangs, often just so they are able to eat, belong to a family, or have some sense of protection even if it is false - it is absolutely heartbreaking. Please continue praying for this desperate situation. Pray also that our students would come to know Jesus and that His light would continue to shine in our community through them and that the people would have HOPE in Him.

CHURCH OF GOD'S GRACE

Sandro continues to be in regular communication with the church leadership in Port as Prince mentoring and encouraging them. The church staff has been actively evangelizing at the school and Sandro is looking for more ways they can serve through Biblical counseling, mentoring, and providing prayer for students and staff. Pray that the church family and the leadership would continue to look to Jesus for all things as well as for Sandro and Alix as they desire to be there in person but continue to lead from a different location in Haiti.

BLOOD PRESSURE CLINIC

We have hired a Haitian nurse in our Port au Prince community who spends time each week providing in home care to those who wouldn't be able to access care otherwise. She monitors their blood pressure and other vitals, helps them with their medication, and prays and shares the gospel with them. There are currently 12 people enrolled. Alix oversees the program.

A highlight for all of us was spending time playing with a little boy that Alix is caring for.

Alix works three days each week at a small clinic where she sees children and wound care patients for free. She provides education and prays with each one. She is also providing daily hospice care for a sweet 9 year old boy who has terminal cancer. He was transported with his mom from Port au Prince to where Alix is living so she could care for him. Sandro is always busy communicating with the people back home in Port au Prince at the school and the church and continuing to provide leadership. He also has a Bible study, an English class, and a children's Bible club in their current neighborhood.
